TALKING TIME

Tell Me A Story

BABY BOOKS

Share board books with Baby. Choose books with a wide variety of simple photographs or pictures. Show Baby how to turn the pages. Point to pictures and name them. Encourage Baby to pat the pictures. Read to Baby with feeling in your voice.

BATH TIME

Tickling/Body Parts

ROUND THE GARDEN

Round and round the garden, Went the Teddy Bear. One step, two steps, Tickle under there.

Draw a circle on Baby's palm. Walk fingers up Baby's arm, then gently tickle.
