WARM-UP PLAY

Parents and children share picture books.

Parents follow their children's lead in play.

Staff mingles with parents asking, "What's new?"

GATHERING AND SETTLING

Parents and staff sing song while helping children to clean up.

CLEAN-UP

Clean up, clean up, everybody, everywhere. Clean up, clean up, everybody do your share.

> Praise your child. Hug, kiss, smile, and say, "Remarkable!"

All greet one another by shaking hands and singing the "Hello" song.

HELLO

Tune: She'll Be Coming Round The Mountain!

WELCOME SONGS

Parents and staff sing each child's name during the song.

Have children jump on individual garden kneeling pads, while holding clackers. Count down from three. Play easy listening background music.

CREATIVE PLAY STATIONS

Free play with theme puzzles, playdoh, Dr. Drew's Discovery Blocks and bubbles

C Staff briefly describes the play stations that are set up throughout the room. Parents follow their children's lead as they explore the play stations.



Children and parents play together at a sensory table filled with colored cotton balls. Provide children with plastic tongs and empty bandage boxes to fill with cotton balls.

CHICKEN POX SPOTS **Creative Play**

Children stamp on paper outlines of poster board boys and girls using red dot painters. Label with children's name and send home.

CHECK-UP

Communication/Pretend Play

Children and parents pretend to go to a doctor's office. Cover table with white bulletin board paper. children's medical kits to examine doll "patients." Provide band-aids. Name body parts.

AMBULANCE RIDE **Active Play**

Children ride in wagons with stuffed animal "patients." Parents pull the wagons around the room and make siren sounds. Also provide small wagons for children to pull.

SNACK TIME

Children, parents, and staff wash hands. Serve snacks individually as the children are seated at the table.

TRANSTION AND FREE CHOICE PLAY

🅦 Staff supports parents as children are prepared for transition. Parents depart for parent education group. Staff follows children's lead as they repeat activities at a creative play station, play with toys throughout the room, go for a walk or a buggy ride, or look at books. Children listen to a variety of types of music as they play.

REGATHERING ACTIVITIES

RING AROUND THE ROSIE

Ring around the rosie, pockets full of posies, Children, children, we all fall down.

MOPEN SHUT THEM

SHARE A BOOK ABOUT DOCTOR VISITS

Tell the story in simple words. Talk about the pictures and ask questions.

REVIEW

Staff reviews the playgroup activities with the children and individually shares with parents what their children did during the parent education group.

Pretend to be doctors, nurses, and patients at home. Use dolls, stuffed animals and band-aids in the play.
